FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question 1 : Why are there some areas in Sabine and Shelby counties that are shaded gray instead of the magenta color?

Response 1: The proposed Broadband Service Area block groups are depicted using a magenta shading. The shading is slightly transparent so that the map's base layer (major roadways) is visible beneath it...The base layer includes some designated forest and wildlife conservation areas in Sabine Shelby, and several other counties, that are part of that layer and cannot be removed. They are typically a shade of green that, when combined with magenta, renders as a gray color. We apologize for this ambiguity. Any person desiring confirmation that their census block group is indeed included in the service area may send their physical address to us and we will be happy to determine the census tract and block group in which you are located, and tell you whether that address is within the Project Service Area.
